

### Trophies for the Championship

The **Bideford Bowl** is awarded to the winners of the Men's Senior coxed fours. It was first presented at the inaugural Regatta at Poole in 1957.

The **Dandridge Cup** is awarded to the winners of the Men's Junior-Senior coxed fours. It was first presented at the 2<sup>nd</sup> Regatta at Deal in 1958.

The **Dudley Ward Cup** is awarded to the winners of the Men's Junior coxed fours. It was first presented at the inaugural Regatta at Poole in 1957.

The **Denis Woodford Cup** is awarded to the winners of the Veteran coxed fours. It was first presented at the 48<sup>th</sup> Regatta at Bideford in 2004.

The **Anglia Building Society Cup** is awarded to the winners of the Ladies' Senior coxed fours. It was first presented at the 23<sup>rd</sup> Regatta at Shanklin & Sandown in 1979.

The **Dartington Crystal Vase** is awarded to the winners of the Ladies' Junior coxed fours. It was first presented at the inaugural Regatta at Poole in 1992.

The **Eileen & Eric Crow Memorial Challenge Cup** is awarded to the Association scoring the most points in the Championship Regatta (5 points for 1<sup>st</sup>, 3 points for 2<sup>nd</sup>, 1 point for 3<sup>rd</sup>). It will be presented for the first time at the 54<sup>th</sup> Regatta here at Wimbleball in 2010. This trophy replaces the Bass Charrington Aggregate Shield.

### Trophies for the Open Regatta

The **Charles Matthews Memorial Cup** is awarded to the winners of the Men's Senior coxed fours. It was first presented at the 15<sup>th</sup> Regatta at Southampton in 1971.

The **Clarice & Dennis Crunden Cup** is awarded to the winners of the Men's Junior-Senior coxed fours. It was first presented at the 25<sup>th</sup> Regatta at Folkestone in 1981.

The **Ginger le Breton Cup** is awarded to the winners of the Men's Junior coxed fours. It was first presented at the 14<sup>th</sup> Regatta at Bideford in 1970.

The **William McLoughlin Cup** is awarded to the winners of the Men's Novice coxed fours. It was first presented at the 20<sup>th</sup> Regatta at Plymouth in 1976.

The **Sidney de Hann Cup** is awarded to the winners of the Veteran over 40 coxed fours. It was first presented at the 45<sup>th</sup> Regatta at Folkestone in 2001.

The **CARA Presidents Cup** is awarded to the winners of the Veteran over 50 coxed fours. It was first presented at the 53<sup>rd</sup> Regatta at Folkestone in 2009.

The **Harold Percy Cup** is awarded to the winners of the Ladies' Senior coxed fours. It was first presented at the inaugural Regatta at Poole in 1957.

The **Mayor of Bideford Cup** is awarded to the winners of the Ladies' Junior coxed fours. It was first presented at the 32<sup>nd</sup> Regatta at Bideford in 1988.

The **Exeter Fund Managers Trophy** is awarded to the winners of the Ladies' Novice coxed fours. It was first presented at the 35<sup>th</sup> Regatta at Southampton in 1991.

The **Port of Dartmouth Royal Regatta Sesquicentennial Regatta Trophy** is awarded to the Club scoring the most points in the Open Regatta (5 points for 1<sup>st</sup>, 3 points for 2<sup>nd</sup>, 1 point for 3<sup>rd</sup>).

The **Debbie Hamilton Trophy** is awarded to the winners of the Ladies J16 Quadruple Sculls. It was first presented at the 50<sup>th</sup> Regatta at Dartmouth in 2006.
